Central Banking, Capitalism, and Global Crisis?

Central Banks have decisively changed their role in the last decades. While they had for a long time mainly been seen as guarantors of monetary stability, they more and more took on the function of political players in manifold respects. This change intensified during the financial crisis after 2008, and once again in the COVID pandemic.
